## Greetings from our Board & Executive Director

The Annual General Meeting each year provides an opportunity to reflect on the past year, and celebrate our success. This year, our Board of Directors were focused on fund development as a means to financial sustainability, and these successful results will enable Aspire to make grand plans for the future. A fund development team was built, leveraged by provincial Community Initiatives Program grant funds. The work of this team generated increased revenues through building and fostering relationships with all funding partners – corporations, foundations, agencies, individuals, community groups and government. Annual events such as the Evening of Decadent Dessert and the Children’s Raffle showed increased revenue as a result of higher attendance, broader community support, and great effort from Aspire parent involvement. Engaging with community service clubs, and being chosen as a charity of choice for community fundraising events were two areas that generated significant momentum for Aspire this year.

Through Aspire’s family-centered programs and services, we directly served more than 250 children with complex and severe needs this past year. Individualized Services, Workshops and Training Seminars, the You Can Ride Two and summer ParkIT Programs all encompass additional ways in which Aspire touches families who have children with special needs. Including referrals and support, Aspire touches over 2,000 families and/or community members each year.

Members of Aspire Staff team are among some of the best trained in their fields of expertise. We strive to stay on the leading edge of innovative practices to ensure the children we serve always receive the best support we can provide. Thank you to our amazing staff team who at the core of the positive energy felt every day at Aspire.

Looking ahead, a Strategic Planning Committee was formed this past year as an ad hoc committee of the Board. The purpose of this Committee is to oversee the development of a new strategic plan for Aspire, as the current plan had a timeframe until 2015, and with many changes since then, it is time again to think about the future. The new Strategic Plan should be finished in early 2015, and will give Aspire a clear picture of our goals and direction for the future.

It was a year filled with many accomplishments and successes, as well as challenges. The progress we made is highlighted in this annual report, and felt every day by the children and families we serve.

## THIS PAST YEAR...

We continued our **Behaviour Training Series For Parents**, helping parents to learn more about behavior issues and strategies. This series was presented with funding from RBC Foundation.

In partnership with Red Deer College, and with funding from ATB Financial, we provided bike training for children with special needs in Central Alberta through our popular **You Can Ride TWO** bike program, now running for the third year.

Our **Evening of Decadent Dessert** was our most successful yet, with over \$200,000 raised, thanks to the support of Central Alberta businesses and families.

Our dedicated group of Aspire Parents volunteered to organize the annual **Walk for Aspire** at Bower Ponds, for the second year. This event raised over \$7,500 for Aspire programs and services.

Volunteers from Nova Chemicals participated in **Days of Caring** by helping with maintenance around our building.

We had a busy Westerner Days week, with donations from events held by **Original Joe's**, as well as the **Red Deer Regional Airport**, in addition to proceeds from the **Kinette** Annual 50/50 Raffle.

With funds donated by **Dow Chemical**, **The Edmonton Oilers Community Foundation**, and **Piper Creek Optimist Club of Red Deer**, we were able to purchase two new SMARTboards for our classrooms.

Two presenters from **Servus Credit Union** delivered two Registered Disability Savings Plan info sessions to Aspire parents & community members.

We received support from **Rotary Club of Red Deer** through a donation to our scholarship fund, while **Rotary Club of Red Deer East** donated to support our EASE Preschool Community Days.

Aspire Board of Directors began the process of establishing a new **Strategic Plan**, as we have come to the end of the time frame for our current plan, and a new plan is needed to reflect Aspire changes.

Staff from our EASE Preschool program attended the annual **Children's Autism Services of Edmonton Conference**, in order to learn from leaders and specialists in the field, network with speakers and attendees, and investigate new products from various specialized vendors.

Through donations from **ERA** and **Computers for Schools**, we received some technology upgrades.

Thanks to the generosity of Aspire supporter Terry Raymond, the children in our EASE Preschool program, their families, and EASE staff, were able to take a field trip to **Discovery Wildlife Park!**

All Aspire staff attended the **Little Warriors Stewards of Children Workshop**, which focuses on the education and prevention of child sexual abuse.

We received tremendous support from **Bo's Bar & Grill**, who donated the proceeds of their annual golf tournament to Aspire, resulting in a donation of nearly \$15,000!

Our **Christmas Light Tour** was enjoyed by over 47 Aspire families, thanks to the support of Jim & Meldy Elliott!

The **Red Deer Firefighters Children's Charity** continued to sponsor our annual festival for children with special needs and their families: Fall into Fun!

Stantec provided Westerner Days tickets to 70 Aspire families through the **We All Play program!** Stantec also supported Aspire by donating the proceeds of their "Boots n' Bling" 50/50 raffle.

Aspire was thrilled to be chosen as the charity of choice for the **Only Women's Fitness Fashion Show**, which resulted in a donation of nearly \$12,000!

We launched our first **Pizza Fundraiser** through Coco Brooks. Pizzas were sold by Aspire parents and staff, and netted enough for Aspire to purchase an AED.

Through the **Triple P Parenting Series**, Aspire was able to support parents of children with a disability to become self-reliant and able to adapt strategies to deal with a wide range of concerns.

Red Flame Industries teamed up with the Festival of Trees to host a **Children's Christmas Party** for 50 Aspire families!

Thanks to funding from TransCanada, our popular summer playgroup, **Park IT**, ran for its third successful year!

A generous donation of \$10,000 was made by **Sky of Dreams Aviation Trust**, to support Aspire programs and services.

### 2014 FINANCIAL COMMENTARY

We incurred a surplus of \$230,129 (before amortization) for the year ended August 31, 2014 compared to a surplus of \$15,434 (before amortization) for the year ended August 31, 2013. Our deferred revenues decreased by \$71,575, which was a result of the remainder of the CIP grant being used for the fund development coordinator position and additional fund-raising revenues being spent.

The board approved a budget with a surplus of \$93,190.03, before amortization, for 2015.
