I am thrilled to share news of the accomplishments and progress made over the past year at Aspire Special Needs Resource Centre. Your ongoing commitment has played a pivotal role in our success, and we are truly grateful for your unwavering support.

One of the highlights of the year was the successful return of our signature event, the Evening of Decadent Desserts. We were elated to welcome back close to 500 guests, and thanks to the overwhelming generosity of our community we raised an impressive net amount of \$130,500. This achievement is a testament to the collective dedication and support of our community, and we are grateful for everyone who contributed to the success of this event, as well as the success of our other fundraisers throughout the year: the Children's Raffle, the 12 Days of Joy Raffle, Aspire's Holiday Night, and Push and Pace.

We are pleased to announce that we secured a grant for the acquisition of a new bus. This addition has proven instrumental in transporting our preschoolers to and from school each day. These buses are outfitted with special accommodations allowing for wheelchairs and other equipment our children use. We were also pleased to receive a Community Service Recovery Grant to help us modernize our systems, making our work more efficient and allowing us to spend more time focusing on the children and families we serve.

This year, Aspire Special Needs Resource Centre was chosen as the charity of choice by many. This endorsement not only serves as a testament to the impact of our work but also opens new avenues for collaboration and community engagement. We are grateful to the community organizations who select us as their charity of choice when they hold events, demonstrating their belief in the value of the work that we do.

As part of our commitment to long-term sustainability, we have made remarkable strides in investing in our future through the Fee Assistance Endowment Fund we created last year. This fund

ensures the accessibility of our services to those in need and sets the foundation for a sustainable and impactful future.

We are delighted to share the successful relaunch of our Park It program over the summer. This initiative provided families with an inclusive outdoor space to enjoy and connect, fostering a sense of community and togetherness. We are grateful for the support of our community in making this happen and look forward to furthering collaborations that empower our community and strengthen the fabric of our shared spaces.

We have diligently updated and reorganized our program offerings to better support our community by enabling a structure that allows for both growth and expansion. Our portfolio now includes Assessment, Consultation, and Training Services (ACTS) and School and Family Services (SFS) alongside our existing preschool program Early Access to Supportive Education (EASE).

I'd like to end this letter with a heartfelt thank you to all Aspire's incredible staff, and in particular to our invaluable Executive Director, JoAnne Hayden. PROGRAMMING 2022-23

From September 1, 2022, to August 31, 2023, Aspire staff were busy providing programs, services and resources to local families, while also planning for and offering events and activities. Here are a few highlights from the past year.

Aspire's Programs

At Aspire, we offer a variety of programming and services for children with diverse needs and their families, including: the Early Access to Supportive Education (EASE) Preschool Program, School and Family Services (SFS) as well as Assessment, Consultation and Training Services (ACTS).

Early Access to Supportive Education (EASE)

The **EASE preschool program** was once again at full capacity in 2022-23, serving **56** students with complex needs onsite. EASE is Aspire's specialized preschool program for children with severe delays or disabilities. We focus on each child's individual strengths and needs to build a solid foundation in this crucial stage of their development. The goal is for families to feel engaged and supported as staff guide their child's learning.

Assessment Consultation and Training Services (ACTS)

Our **Assessment Consultation and Training Services** team provides services to children and families in a variety of ways. Families can choose which format best suits the needs of their child and their family as a whole.

36 children and **72** parents were supported through the 6-week program - Transdisciplinary Assessment and Consultation (TAC).

56 children and **112** parents were supported through our Diagnostic Clinics and Consultation Services.

Group training services were not available.

School and Family Services (SFS)

Aspire's **School and Family Services** team provides assessment, consultation and skill building within the school environment. Other programs provide parents with the resources, strategies, and tools to help their child learn skills and participate in daily routines. Aspire therapists have a family centered, multidisciplinary approach when providing services in the home, at Aspire and/or in the community.

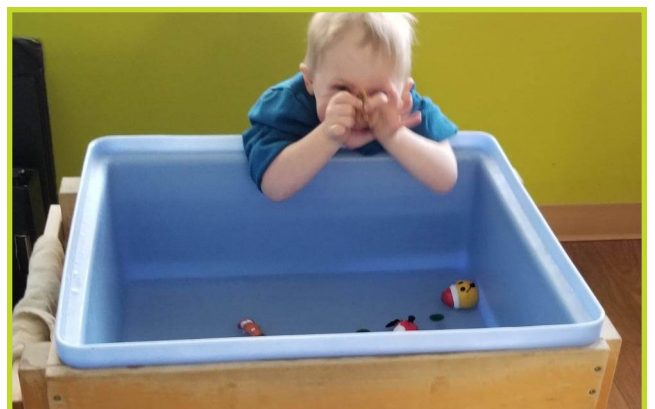
25 children and **50** parents supported with FSCD contracts.

Desert returned Thursday, September 29, 2022 at the Parkland Pavilion in Red Deer. This event is Aspire's largest fundraiser of the year, taking months to plan with the help of over 70 volunteers. Close to 500 guests filled the venue to support children with diverse needs and their families in Central Alberta.

The highlight of the evening was the Live Auction featuring 14 unique packages from across Central Alberta, each with a dessert created by local bakers. The Live Auction, combined with the silent auction and other event raffles, raised over \$130,500. 

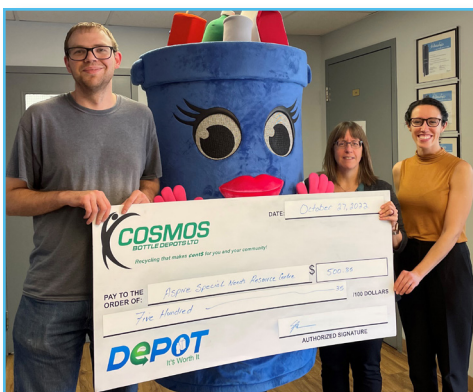
